Alexicon Telecommunications Consulting, Inc. (Alexicon) requests Special Permission to waive Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's Rules in order to withdraw the tariff revisions filed under Transmittal No. 8 before they become effective.

On December 1, 2012, Alexicon filed Transmittal No. 8, which proposed a name change for Columbus Telephone Company, Inc. to Columbus Communications Services, LLC and to reduce DSL speeds and rates for Lake Livingston Telephone Company, Inc. Transmittal No. 8 is scheduled to become effective December 16, 2012.

Since Transmittal No. 8 was filed on an improper notice period, Alexicon requests permission to waive Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's Rules in order to withdraw the tariff revisions, without them becoming effective, and to restore currently effective material.

A waiver of Section 61.58 is requested to permit the revisions of tariff material to become effective on not less than one day's notice. A waiver of Section 61.59 is requested to permit revisions to tariff material that is not yet in effect.


