SECTION 5- SWITCHED ACCESS RATES

5.1 General

This section contains the specific regulations governing the rates and charges that apply for Switched Access Services:

There are three types of rates and charges that apply to Switched Access Service:

- Non-Recurring Charges: One-time charges that apply for a specific work activity.
- Recurring Charges: Fixed charges apply each month and depend on the number and type of facilities in place.
- Usage Charges: Charges that are applied on a per access minute basis. Usage rates are accumulated over a monthly period.

5.2 Rate Categories

There are several rate categories that apply to Switched Access Service:

- Local Transport
- End Office
- Chargeable Optional Features

5.4 Rates and Charges where the End User Premises of the calling End User (in the case of originating access) or the called End User (in the case of terminating access) is within Service Area of Hart Telephone Company: In this situation, the Company's switched access rates are intended to mirror the current interstate switched access rates of the competing Incumbent Local Exchange Carrier (ILEC), Hart Telephone Company.
