The purpose of this filing is to reduce the Residential End User Common Line charge for CCTX and CCFB to \$0.00. CCTX and CCFB are going through significant rate rebalancing in their operating areas and in an effort to mitigate ratepayer effects and simplify customer billing have elected to zero out the residential EUCL. There are no other rate or revenue impacts.
