DESCRIPTION & JUSTIFICATION

Cincinnati Bell Telephone (CBT) proposes to make the following changes with this filing:

- CBT proposes to add 12-month and 24-month Optional Payment Plan (OPP) and Discount Commitment Plan (DCP) options to its OC-3/STM-1, OC-12/STM-4, OC-48/STM-16 and OC-192/STM-64 Dedicated Ring Service.
- CBT proposes to remove the OC-48 Customer Premises Node, Central Office Nodes and OC-48 Add/Drop Capability Dedicated Ring Service rate elements that were grandfathered via Transmittal No. 789 in March, 2004. The maximum available term for those elements was 60 months. Therefore, the maximum term for those elements would have ended in March, 2009.
- CBT proposes to restructure its Section 19 - Cincinnati Bell Ethernet Service to remove the rate elements for additional ports. CBT has had no customer demand for the additional port elements.
- CBT proposes to add 12-month, 24-month, 36-month, 48-month, 60-month, and 84-month OPP and DCP 10 Gbps and 100 Gbps rate elements to its Section 21-Wavelength Point-to-Point Service.

- CBT proposes to add Committed Information Rate (CIR) 5 Mbps Unprotected Port rate elements to its Section 19 - Cincinnati Bell Ethernet Service.
- CBT proposes to Grandfather its Section 18 Frame Relay Service. The equipment needed to continue the service had been manufacturer discontinued. The few remaining Frame Relay customers have been offered Ethernet solutions and have expressed plans to transition from Frame Relay over the next few months.
