The End User Common Line Charge serves to recover the interstate allocation of the cost of the telephone line or trunk connected from the Customer's Premises to the Public Switched Telephone Network. The charge is assessed per line per month.

5.6 Access Recovery Charge

A monthly Access Recovery Charge is assessed in order to facilitate access recovery partly as a result of both state and federal decisions and policies. The fee is applied as follows:

5.7 Local Number Portability Charge

The Local Number Portability Charge is assessed per local voice access line. This monthly recurring charge recovers costs associated with the provision of local number portability. Such portability allows Customers to retain their assigned telephone number(s) when switching carriers or service locations.
