This filing is made pursuant to the Bureau's Suspension Order DA 13-2349 (Order), released December 9, 2013.

On November 25, 2013, NBTC issued its Transmittal No. 254, which proposed to grandfather term plans of 60 months or greater for High Capacity DS1 and DS3 services, and Fractional DS1 service. Transmittal No. 254 was scheduled to become effective on December 10, 2013.

The aforementioned Order suspends the tariff revision, filed under Transmittal No. 254, for five months, to May 10, 2014. For this purpose, the Order waives the following sections of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. §§ 61.58, 61.59 and 61.86.

In accordance with Section 61.14, this transmittal letter and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS) in compliance with the electronic filing procedures.
