1. Introduction

Frontier Telephone Companies ("Frontier") submits herewith its Description and Justification ("D&J") in support of changes to its Access Tariffs made under Transmittal No. 47. This filing is made on behalf of the exchange carriers issuing Frontier Telephone Companies Tariffs FCC Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 10.

2. Administrative Changes

Some of the issuing carriers for Tariffs FCC Nos. 5, 6, and 10 have had legal name changes. This filing updates these tariffs to reflect the changes of legal names for the affected carriers. It has recently come to Frontier's attention that the DS3 Direct Trunk Transport rates in Tariff FCC No. 3 were incorrectly labeled as DS1 rates. Frontier corrects the description in this filing.

3. USF Recovery Charge and FUSF Surcharge

On December 13, 2013, the Commission released a *Public Notice*, Proposed First Quarter 2014 Universal Service Contribution Factor,

DA 13-2388 ("*1Q14 USF Notice*"). The *1Q14 USF Notice* proposes a universal service contribution factor of 16.4% for the first quarter of 2014. In this filing, Frontier changes its USF Recovery Charge¹ rate element for Tariffs FCC Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 10 to 16.4% in keeping with the change in the underlying contribution factor.

¹ This rate element is called "Universal Service Fund (USF) Recovery Charge" in Tariffs FCC Nos. 1, 2, and 3; "Federal Universal Service Fund (FUSF) Surcharge" in Tariffs FCC Nos. 4, 5, and 6; and "Federal Universal Service Charge (FUSC)" in Tariff FCC No. 10.
