On November 25, 2013, NBTC issued its Transmittal No. 254, which proposed to grandfather term plans of 36 months or greater for High Capacity DS1 and DS3 services and Fractional DS1 service. Transmittal No. 254 was scheduled to become effective on December 10, 2013.

On December 9, 2013, the FCC released its Order DA 13-2349, which suspended the tariff revisions filed under Transmittal No. 254 for five months. On December 12, 2013, NBTC issued Supplement 8 under Transmittal No. 255 suspending Transmittal 254 for five months, until May 10, 2014.

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With this filing, NBTC proposes to withdraw material filed under Transmittal No. 254 without its becoming effective, and to restore currently effective material..

In accordance with Section 61.14, this transmittal letter and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS) in compliance with the electronic filing procedures.
