
With this filing CBT proposes to make changes in Section 6 – Switched Access pursuant to the Federal Communications Commission (FCC)'s Report and Order and Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (USF/ICC Order) FCC No. 11-161 released November 18, 2011 to split specific rate elements into origination and terminating elements.

CBT also proposes to revise its Universal Service Fund (USF) contribution factor pursuant to the Commission's Proposed Second Quarter 2014 Universal Service Contribution Factor, DA 14-337, released March 12, 2014.
