Dear Ms. Dortch:

On March 31, 2014, The Pioneer Telephone Association, Inc. d/b/a Pioneer Communications ("Pioneer Communications"), notified the Federal Communications Commission that it will discontinue its wireline broadband Internet access service offerings under Pioneer Communications Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 effective May 1, 2014 (*See* Letter to Marlene H. Dortch, Secretary, Federal Communications Commission, from Kenneth C. Johnson, Counsel, Pioneer Communications, *Erratum: Notice of Discontinuance of Common Carrier Broadband Internet Access Transmission Service*, WC Docket No. 02-33 (filed April 1, 2014)). Pioneer Communications has elected to detariff its wireline broadband Internet access service pursuant to the Federal Communications Commission's 2005 Wireline Broadband Report and Order (*See Appropriate Framework for Broadband Access to the Internet over Wireline Facilities, Universal Service Obligations of Broadband Providers et al.*, CC Docket No. 02-33 et al., Report and Order and Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, 20 FCC Rcd 14853, FCC 05-150 (2005)).

Upon discontinuance of its tariffed offerings, Pioneer will provide wireline broadband Internet access service on a common-carriage, non-tariffed basis. This filing, scheduled to become effective May 1, 2014, contains revised tariff material, to reflect Pioneer Communications' decision to provide such service on a common-carriage, non-tariffed basis.
