Enclosed for submission to the Federal Communications Commission ("Commission") is BCN Telecom, Inc.'s ("BCN" or "Company") switched exchange access tariff F.C.C. Tariff No. 5. This tariff replaces in its entirety BCN's Tariff F.C.C. No. 4.

BCN's Tariff F.C.C. No. 5 sets forth the Company's rates, terms, and conditions for the provision of interstate switched access services. BCN has included provisions governing Voice over Internet Protocol telephony – Public Switched Telephone Network traffic termination, end user access service, and incorporated rate citations to incumbent local exchange carrier ("ILEC") switched exchange access tariffs for those ILECs in the service territory the Company operates, in accordance with 47 CFR §61.25(b) to comply with the incumbent carrier switched exchange access rate benchmarking requirements contained in 47 CFR §61.26. The Company also introduces in accordance with 47 CFR §51.915(e) a Carrier Access Recovery Charge, and incorporates Federal Universal Service Fund Fees.

An FCC Remittance Advice Form 159, and payment of the Commission's tariff filing fee in the amount of \$845.00 is being sent to U.S. Bank in St. Louis Missouri.
