With this transmittal, Verizon is implementing a single composite terminating end office charge (CTEOC) to replace eligible revenue recovery that would have been collected from existing terminating end office Local Switching, Shared Trunk Port, and Dedicated Trunk Port rate elements, i.e. those existing rate elements or applicable portions will be zero-rated as of July 1, 2014. CTEOC rates were calculated at a state-level in compliance with Section 51.907(d)(2)(iii) of the FCC ICC Reform Order.
