Cincinnati Bell Telephone (CBT) is filing an amended Transmittal No. 886 to submit a revised Page 106.124 in order to reflect the Terminating Local Switching rate reduction inadvertently omitted from Transmittal No. 886.


The original filing was filed June 16, 2014 and was made on 15 days' notice and included the following: CBT proposed in Transmittal No 886 to make changes in Section 6 – Switched Access as part of its 2014 Annual Access Filing and Inter-carrier Compensation (ICC) Filing to decrease the Terminating Local Switching rate. CBT explained the reduction in the Terminating Local Switching rate in its Description & Justification. Additionally CBT's ICC file ACCREDTRP shows the revised Terminating Local Switching rate.

The tariff pages included with this letter are scheduled to become effective July 1, 2014.
