The purpose of this filing is to modify the Company's interstate switched access End Office rates. The modifications are in response to the Federal Communications Commission's Report and Order and Further Notice of Proposed rulemaking, WC Docket Nos. 10-90 et al., FCC 11-161, § 51.909 (d) Step 3 (Released Nov 18, 2011).

Additional Switched Access rates are changing to be in compliance with the Benchmarking Rule (CRF SS 6.26) and the CLEC Access Reform Order (16 FCC Red at 9925, para 3), which state that CLECs are permitted to tariff interstate access charges at a level no higher than the tarified rates for such services offered by the ILEC serving the same geographical area.

TDS Metrocom's Middleton Market provides service in the same geographical area as Mid-Plains Telephone Company. Mid-Plains Telephone Company has exited the NECA pool and is now an issuing carrier of the John Staurulakis, Inc. (JSI) FCC Tariff No. 1. With exiting the NECA pool, Mid-Plains has reduced several rates. To maintain parity, the Middleton Market will also reduce these additional rates.
