2.6 Definitions (Cont'd)

Service Order: A written request for Access Services initiated by the Customer to the Company in the format devised by the Company. It is sometimes referred to as an Access Service request (ASR). The signing of a Service Order by the Customer and acceptance by the Company initiates the respective obligations of the parties set forth herein pursuant to this tariff, but the duration of service is calculated from the Service Commencement Date.

Service Commencement Date: The first day following the date on which the Company notifies the Customer that the requested service or facility is available for use, unless extended by the Customer's refusal to accept service which does not conform to standards set forth in the Service Order or this tariff. In the latter case, the Service Commencement Date is the date of the Customer's acceptance. The parties may mutually agree on a substitute Service Commencement Date.

Special Access Service: Generally dedicated (private line) facilities between two or more Customer Designated Premises.

Switched Access Service: Access to the Company's local switch network by an interexchange carrier for the purposes of originating and/or terminating jurisdictional communications.

Toll VoIP-PSTN Traffic: Denotes a customer's interexchange voice traffic exchanged with the Company in Time Division Multiplexing format over PSTN Facilities, which originates and/or terminates in Internet Protocol (IP) format. Toll VoIP-PSTN Traffic originates and/or terminates in IP format when it originates from and/or terminates to an end user customer of a service that requires IP-compatible customer premises equipment.

Transport Interconnection Charge: A per-access minute charge applicable to transport per FCC CC Docket No. 91-213, Report and Order, March 5, 1998.

Wire Center: A building in which the Company's switching center is located for the purpose of providing service.

2.7 Identification and Rating of Toll VoIP-PSTN Traffic

The following provision applies to the treatment of Toll VoIP-PSTN Traffic pursuant to the Federal Communications Commission's Part 51 Interconnection Rules and in compliance with the Federal Communications Commission's Report and Order and Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in CC Docket Nos. 96-45 and 01-92; GN Docket No. 09-51; WC Docket Nos. 03-109, 05-337, 07-135 and 10-90; and WT Docket No. 10-208, adopted October 27, 2011 and released November 18, 2011 (FCC 11-161). In the absence of an interconnection agreement between the Company and the customer specifying the treatment of Toll VoIP-PSTN Traffic, the Company will bill the customer the applicable switched access rates and charges specified in Section 11, following, on all jurisdictionally interstate voice traffic identified as Toll VoIP-PSTN Traffic.

6. SWITCHED ACCESS SERVICE – Feature Group D Switched Service6.1 General

Switched Access Service provides for the use of common switching, terminating, and trunking facilities between a Customer Designated Premises and an end-users premises for originating and terminating traffic. The Company provides Feature Group D Switched Access (Equal Access) service, which is furnished in quantities of trunks or busy hour minutes of capacity (BHMC). Feature Group D Switched Access Service consists of local transport and the appropriate end office switching and functions to enable an interexchange carrier Customer to provide message toll service (MTS), wide area telephone service (WATS), directory information and 1+, or when required an access code of 1010 XXX, services.

6.1.1 Rate Categories

Certain of the rate elements included within the Company's offering of Switched Access Services have been revised to comply with the requirement that the company's rates be no higher than the competing ILEC (Frontier Telephone Companies, Tariff FCC No. 5). The new rates are reflected in Section 11. (T)

Rate categories and descriptions include the following:

6.1.1.1 Entrance Facility charge — a flat-rate charge which provides the communications path between a customer designated premises and the serving wire center.

Local Transport — charges for trunks related to the transmission and tandem switching facilities, if appropriate, between the customer designated premises and the end office switch where the customer's originating or terminating traffic is switched. Local Transport rate categories consist of three elements: a Local Transport Termination per path per access minute charge, a Local Transport Facility rate per mile per access minute charge, and a Transport Interconnect Charge rate per access minute. A Customer may also request optional features and functions which have appropriate charges.
