This filing is made to revise rates of the rural CLECs that are permitted to tariff switched access rates up to the highest rate band in the NECA tariff as stated in F.C.C.'s Eighth Report and Order CC Docket No. 96-262. Also, this filing reduces terminating switched end office rates by one-third of the differential between end office rates and \$0.0007 for CLECs that benchmark access rates to price cap carriers pursuant to the FCC 11-161 Order. Finally, this filing is adding rates and charges for Anderson Telephone Inc., Carrboro Telephone Inc., and Kinloch Telephone Inc.
