The accompanying tariff material, issued by Consolidated Communications Companies (CCC; FRN #0010-1553-98), consisting of Consolidated Communications of Texas Company (CCTX) and Consolidated Communications of Fort Bend Company (CCFB) and bearing F.C.C. Tariff No. 1 Access Service, and Consolidated Communications of Pennsylvania (CCPA) bearing Tariff F.C.C. No. 2 Access Service, is sent to you for filing in compliance with the requirements of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended.

This filing is to correct an administrative oversight in our July filing. In the July Annual Access filing, we applied the access reductions to our end office rates – Information Surcharge, Common Trunk Port and Dedicated Trunk Port, but failed to split out the rate elements as originating and terminating and maintaining the correct originating rate. We have been billing these rate elements, for originating traffic, at the lower terminating rate since July 1, 2014 for the Information Surcharge and the Common Trunk Port.

With this tariff filing, we have made the correction by splitting these end office rates into originating and terminating; changing the originating rate back to what it was prior to June 16 filing for Information Surcharge (CCTX, CCFB, CCPA) and Common Trunk Port (CCTX/CCFB). For the Dedicated Trunk port, we are revising the calculation and splitting the rate elements into originating and terminating (CCTX/CCFB).

The filing, to become effective October 18, 2014, consists of revised tariff pages as indicated on the check sheets attached.

In compliance with Section 61.14 of the Commission's Rules, the transmittal, associated files, required form 159 and \$910.00 filing fee are being transmitted electronically today via the Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System.
