This application is hereby made by Nevada Bell Telephone Company (NBTC) for Special Permission to waive Section 61.74 of the Commission's Rules in order to make references in NBTC Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Contract Offers No. 28 and 29, to the similar contract tariff offerings in Frontier Telephone Companies (Frontier) Tariff F.C.C. No. 11.

With this application, NBTC requests permission to waive Section 61.74 of the Commission's Rules in order to include the above mentioned tariff references in its filing which moves contracts, having concurrent subscriptions with Frontier, to a separate section . This action is necessitated by the sale of The Southern New England Telephone Company by AT&T to Frontier Communications. Frontier has received a waiver to make similar references in their Tariff FCC No. 11, which becomes effective on October 25, 2014.

An Application to waive Section 61.74 of the Commission's Rules is also being requested for Ameritech Operating Companies (Ameritech) Tariff F.C.C. No. 2, BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC (BellSouth) Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Pacific Bell Telephone Company (PBTC) Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, and Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) Tariff F.C.C. No. 73, in separate filings.
