This application is hereby made by AT&T Operating Companies (AT&T) for Special Permission to waive Section 61.58 of the Commission's Rules in order to file on one day's notice to remove The Southern New England Telephone Company (SNET) as an issuing carrier from AT&T Operating Companies Tariff F.C.C. No. 1.

This action is necessitated due to the sale of SNET by AT&T to Frontier Communications (Frontier). Frontier has filed Frontier Tariff FCC No. 12, which becomes effective on October 25, 2014, which will replace material relevant to Connecticut.
