## (h) Account Fee

The Account Fee defrays costs associated with the management and servicing of residential and business accounts.

| <u>Billed Monthly Revenue</u> | <u>Monthly Account Fee</u> |

| \$0 to \$50                   | \$4.95                     |
| \$50.01 to \$150              | \$4.95                     |
| \$150.01 to \$350             | \$6.95                     |

| \$1,000.01 to \$3,000         | \$13.95                    |
| \$3,000.01 to \$5,000         | \$16.95                    |
| \$5,000.01 and over           | \$21.95                    |

- (i) The Regulatory Adjustment Fee recovers operational costs incurred in the provision and maintenance of telephone service. This includes network costs and costs associated with terminating calls to end users. The surcharge will be recovered through monthly charges assessed to end users upon whom End User Common Line Charges are applied.
