

The Commission issued Public Notice No. DA-1745 regarding CBT's Section 214 Application on December 3, 2014. The Commission stated in the Public Notice that, absent further Commission action, CBT could discontinue LAN Advantage Frame Relay Service on or after February 1, 2015.
