This filing implements revisions to GLC's switched access rates to comply with the provisions of Commission Rule 61.26, 47 C.F.R. § 61.26, as that rule was interpreted by the Commission in *AT&T Services, Inc. and AT&T Corp. v. Great Lakes Comnet, Inc. and Westphalia Telephone Company*, File No. EB 14-MD-013, Memorandum Opinion and Order, FCC 15-31 (rel. Mar. 18, 2015) (the "Order").

It should be noted that the Order is currently subject to a Petition for Review filed with the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit, pending in Case No. 15-

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1064. By submitting these tariff revisions, GLC does not concede or otherwise admit in any way, either expressly or implicitly, that the Order or any finding thereunder – including without limitation the Commission’s interpretation and application of Commission Rule 61.26 – is lawful or otherwise waive any right to challenge the Order. Rather, GLC reserves the right to make any appropriate revisions to these tariff sheets to the extent the Order is vacated, enjoined, set aside, suspended (in whole or in part), overturned or otherwise invalidated on appeal.

This filing is made on 15 days’ notice pursuant to Section 204(a)(3) of the Act. GLC is a non-dominant carrier and, therefore, supporting documentation under Part 61.38 of the Commission’s Rules is not required.

In accordance with Part 61.14(b) of the Commission’s Rules, the tariff filing fee of \$910.00 is being submitted electronically via credit card as part of the ETFS filing process.
