This application for special permission requests waiver of the requirements of Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Federal Communications Commission's Rules in order to file revisions the Olsen Thielen F.C.C NO 2 ACCESS SERVICE tariff on not less than one day's notice.

In this filing, Olsen Thielen corrects an error filed under Transmittal No. 46. In F.C.C. No 2, the special access Channel Mileage Termination Monthly rate was inadvertently left unchanged, and did not reflect a reduction of the monthly rate.
