This letter is being filed on behalf of BVU Authority d/b/a OptiNet to clarify the status of its tariffs on the ETFS. On July 16, 2014, BVU d/b/a OptiNet filed a new tariff, which superceded and canceled the City of Bristol, dba Bristol Virginia Utilities also dba BVU OptiNet, also dba BVUB, also dba OptiNet, also dba BVU. Instead of filing a new Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 under the new legal name of BVU Authority using a new Login, Password and FRN, BVU filed a new FCC Tariff F.C.C. No. 3, which was filed to replace FCC Tariff No. 2 under the Login, Password and FRN of the City of Bristol. This filing, made on July 16, 2014, was submitted in compliance with the FCC ICC Reform Order and made the appropriate rate changes.

For the reasons stated above, there are no Tariff F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 2 on file for BVU Authority.
