This application is hereby made by BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC (BellSouth) for Special Permission to waive Section 61.59(c) of the Commission's Rules in order to withdraw Transmittal No. 108.

On October 30, 2015, BellSouth filed Transmittal No. 108, its Contract Offer No. 85, which became effective on October 31, 2015. Along with BellSouth Contract Offer No. 85, filed under Transmittal No. 108, four other identical tariffed contracts were filed in the other AT&T currently effective interstate access tariffs.

With this Application, BellSouth requests special permission to waive Section 61.59(c) of the Commission's Rules in order to withdraw, on not less than one day's notice, the tariff material filed under Transmittal No. 108. BellSouth wishes to withdraw Transmittal No. 108 in order to correct typographical errors and review issues identified in the proposed modifications.
