Dear Secretary Dortch

Pursuant to Section 61.131 *et seq*, 47 C.F.R. §§61.131 *et seq*, Sigecom, LLC dba WOW! Internet Cable Phone ("WOW!") hereby reports that its affiliate, Knology of Kansas, Inc. dba WOW! Internet, Cable and Phone ("Knology") assents to and concurs in the tariff described below. Knology thus makes itself a party to these tariffs and obligates itself and its connecting carriers to observe every provision in them, until a notice of revocation is filed with the Commission and delivered to WOW!.

This concurrence applies to interstate communication:

1. Between the different points on the concurring carrier's network;
2. Between all points on the concurring carrier's network and the networks of its connecting carriers; and
3. Between all points on the system of the concurring carrier and the systems of its connecting carriers on the one hand, and, on the other hand, all points on the system of WOW!'s tariff listed below and the networks of its connecting carriers and other carriers with which through routes have been established.
