The Verizon Telephone Companies (Verizon) hereby apply for Special Permission for a waiver of Section 61.59 of the Commission's rules.

On February 16, 2016, Verizon filed Transmittal No. 1329 under Tariff FCC No. 21, Special Construction, a portion of which included introducing two new cases in the State of Texas. Transmittal No. 1329 became effective on March 2, 2016.

On March 16, 2016, Verizon plans to file tariff revisions under Tariff FCC No. 21 to remove regulations, rates and charges required as a result of its transfer of certain assets, liabilities, and contracts to Frontier Communications Corporation. Such revisions will include removal of the two Texas cases filed under Transmittal No. 1329.

A waiver of Section 61.59 is required in order to revise material that has not been in effect for thirty days.

This application and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS).
