Cincinnati Bell Telephone (CBT) is filing a correction to Transmittal No. 896 to submit a revised tariff PDF file containing all of the pages applicable to Transmittal No. 896. The PDF tariff file originally filed in transmittal No. 896 was missing pages that were intended to be included in the filing due to a technical error.

The original filing was filed today, March 17, 2016 and was made on 15 days' notice and proposed the following:

CBT proposed to revise its Universal Service Fund (USF) contribution factor pursuant to the Commission's Proposed 2nd Quarter 2016 Universal Service Contribution Factor, DA 16- 266 released March 10, 2016.

CBT also proposed to remove tariff language from Section 6 - Switched Access Service which was erroneously included in Transmittal No. 883, effective April 1, 2014.


CBT also proposed to revise the footnote found on tariff pages found in Section 7 – Special Access pertaining to Metallic Service and Digital Data Service.

This correction is scheduled to become effective April 1, 2016.
