With this filing, Midcontinent Communications complies with the July 2016 step down requirements set forth by the Federal Communications Commission's Order FCC No. 11-161 (released on November 18, 2011) and rule 47 C.F.R. § 61.26 "Tariffing of competitive interstate switched exchange access services." To comply with this rule, Midcontinent Communications is reducing its terminating switched access rates to the levels of the corresponding dominant incumbent local exchange carrier's (CenturyLink Qwest's) rates.

Midcontinent Communications is a non-dominant carrier and, therefore, cost support documentation under Part 61.38 of the Commission's Rules is not required.

In addition, Midcontinent Communications is changing contact information in the footer of each page of the tariff. Thus, all pages now include this updated information.
