Pursuant to the Federal Communications Commission's Report and Order reforming the intercarrier compensation and universal service systems, 26 FCC Rcd 17663 ("FCC Order"), and the Public Utility Commission's Order, Grande Communications Networks, LLC ("Grande") encloses a revised switched access tariff to reflect implementation of the FCC's Step 5 (or "Phase" 5) Transitional Intrastate Access Service rate reductions. The Step 5 reductions went into effect on July 1, 2016. The revised pages include:
