The Chillicothe Telephone Company (“Chillicothe”) hereby requests Special Permission to withdraw Transmittal No. 112 (filed January 3, 2017) to its Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 before it becomes effective on January 18, 2017, and to reinstate its currently effective tariff materials.

Waivers of Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's Rules are needed in order for Chillicothe to withdraw the rates and regulations in Transmittal No. 112 (which rates and regulations have not yet become effective) on one day's notice, and to reinstate its current effective rates and regulations.
