Dear Ms. Dortch:

Today, Hawaiian Telcom is filing its 2017 Annual Access Tariff filing for Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Access Services under Transmittal No. 129, which is being filed on 15 days' notice pursuant to the Commission's "Tariff Streamlining Order".

Because of the competitively sensitive nature, Hawaiian Telcom has redacted certain demand data associated with their 2017 Annual Price Cap Filing. Accordingly, Hawaiian Telcom is hereby requesting, pursuant to Sections 0.457 and 0.459 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R., Section 0.457 and 0.459, pursuant to Exemption 4 of the Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"), 5 U.S.C. Section 552(b)(4), and pursuant to the Tariff Streamlining Order and rules adopted thereunder, that such demand data be treated as confidential and be made subject to the standard Protective Order and Declaration adopted by the Commission in the Tariff Streamlining Order issued by the Commission in Public Notice DA 17-550 issued June 6, 2017 in WC Docket No. 17-65.

Under Exemption 4 of the FOIA, commercial or financial information is held to be confidential, and thus entitled to protection, if disclosure of such information would, inter alia, be likely to cause substantial harm to the competitive position of the person from whom the information was obtained. See *National Parks and Conservation Ass'n v. Morton*, 498 F.2d 765, 770 (D.C. Cir. 1974); *Critical Mass Energy Project v. NRC*, 830 F.2d 278 (D.C. Cir. 1987).

The information for which Hawaiian Telcom seeks confidential treatment is competitively sensitive demand data which, if made available to competitors and alternate providers, would provide such entities with valuable information regarding Hawaiian Telcom's customer base in particular zones within the state. This information, which is otherwise not publicly available, would assist competitors in targeting their marketing efforts to the areas with the largest concentrations of customers. For the reason cited above, Hawaiian Telcom respectfully requests that the Commission grant confidential treatment to certain detailed demand information submitted in their 2017 Annual Price Cap Filing and that such information be subject to the standard protective order provided for in the Tariff Streamlining Order. Pursuant to the non-disclosure agreement that provides for review of information granted confidential treatment by interested parties, for the specific purpose of review and comment on the instant transmittal only, Hawaiian Telcom will provide access and review of such information to signatories of such an agreement at the location listed below.
