RE: Transmittal Number 54 - 2017 Annual Access Charge Tariff Filing Eligible Recovery Corrections with Revised TRP Files

Dear Ms. Dortch:

The accompanying tariff material in Transmittal No. 54 is sent to you to correct an error in Alaska Communications Systems Group, Inc. (ACS) Transmittal No. 53 in FCC Tariff No. 1, filed on June 16, 2017. ACS is proposing to correct its originally filed Multiline Business ARC rate. The revised tariff material reflects a change required by CFR 51.913(b)(9) to reduce the Non-CALLs base factor on the Eligible Recovery Form from 100% down to 90% for all of ACS Non-CALLs study areas effective 7/1/17. ACS originally had all its study areas classified as Non-CALLs study areas using 100% on the Eligible Recovery TRP Form. Because of this change, ACS is including a revised Eligible Recovery file (ACSTER17.- corrected.xls) and all three associated ARC files (ACSTTRC17 – corrected.xls, ACSTARC17 – corrected, and ACSTSUMER17 – corrected) with this filing.

The net effect of this base percentage change to ACS Non-CALLs study areas reduced the Eligible Recovery from \$1,454,160 as originally filed in Transmittal 53 down to \$1,310,468 in this transmittal. ACS is making this filing on behalf of the following local exchange subsidiaries.

ACS of Anchorage, LLC
ACS of Fairbanks, LLC
ACS of Alaska, LLC (Juneau & Greatland Study Areas)
ACS of the Northland, LLC (Glacier State & Sitka Study Areas)

The reduction in Eligible Recovery only impacts ACS Multiline Business ARC rate. ACS files Transmittal No. 54 to correct its Multiline ARC rate on a 7-day notice period pursuant to the commissions tariffing rules under Section 204(A)(3) Of The Act as it is a reduction.

In accordance with the requirements of Section 61.21(a)(3) of the Commission's rule, the FCC Registration Number for the filing entities are shown below:
