In this filing, AT&T Corp. proposes to reduce terminating end office switching charges to zero. Because AT&T Corp. does not maintain tandems, there are no terminating tandem elements required to be split between terminating to end office and terminating to third parties. The terminating tandem rates contained in this tariff are benchmarked to the incumbent LEC "terminating to third party" rates.

Also, AT&T Corp. proposes to change the Presubscribed Interexchange Carrier Charges (PICC) rates.
