5.2 Application of Rates

Originating 101XXXX/8NN FG Access: Usage rates will apply to the total number of recorded minutes of use during the billing period. Usage rates will apply to both Tandem Connect Access and Direct Connect Access as set forth in 5.4.2. In addition, non-recurring rates may apply to Tandem Connect Access, and non-recurring and monthly recurring rates may apply to Direct Connect Access. These non-recurring and monthly recurring rates will be developed on an individual case basis (see Section 8).

Terminating FG Access: Usage rates will apply to the total number of recorded minutes of use during the billing period. Usage rates will apply to both Tandem Connect Access and Direct Connect Access as set forth in 5.4.2. In addition, non-recurring rates may apply to Tandem Connect Access, and non-recurring and monthly recurring rates may apply to Direct Connect Access. These non-recurring and monthly recurring rates will be developed on an individual case basis (see Section 8).

Originating 8NN FG Access Query: In addition to all other applicable usage charges, a data base query charge will apply per originating 8NN message.

The terminating switched transport rate schedules are bifurcated into “3rd Party” and “End Office” rates. The Company bills the End Office terminating switched transport rates, in accordance with Commission Rules 51.907(g)(2) and 51.907(g), for “terminating traffic traversing a tandem switch that the terminating carrier or its affiliates owns.” All other terminating switched transport traffic is billed the 3rd Party terminating switched transport rates. SECTION 6 - MISCELLANEOUS CHARGES, (CONT'D)**6.3 Federal Universal Service Fee**

In connection with the FCC's Universal Service Orders, Cbeyond will pay a percentage of its retail revenues to support the Universal Service Fund (USF). Cbeyond will pass-through the USF assessment to its customers by assessing a charge applicable against all retail interstate and international charges, including usage and non-usage charges. This surcharge is in addition to standard tariffed usage charges and any applicable service charges and surcharges associated with the Company's service. The Company's Universal Service Fee factor will match the relevant quarterly Universal Service Contribution Factor approved by the FCC. Universal Service Contribution Factors are available at www.fcc.gov/ccb/universal_service/quarter.html.

6.2 Access Recovery Fee

The purpose of the Access Recovery Fee is to partially offset the Company's costs to provide services, support its infrastructure, and recover costs associated with the federally mandated reduction in carrier access rates resulting from the FCC's 2011 Universal Service Fund/Intercarrier Compensation Reform Order.
