With this filing, Verizon submits tariff pages to further modify certain tariff provisions related to Special Access Services in Tariff FCC Nos. 1, 11, 14 and 16 in compliance with the FCC's Business Data Services Order².

With this filing, Verizon will:

- Reinstate Price Cap rates for Bridging Optional Features and Functions in FCC1, FCC11, FCC14 and FCC16, Additional Audio Channels, an Optional Feature and Function for Video in FCC1, Non-Standard Premises Connection Charges in FCC1 and FCC11, and Voiceband Service Special Access Lines in FCC14.
- Remove Price Cap rates for IntelliLight Shared Assurance Network service in FCC1, certain Rearrangement Charges and Video CODEC in FCC11, and for a Multiplexing Arrangement in FCC14. Price Band rates and charges will apply to these rate elements.

Also as part of this filing, Verizon will make the following administrative revisions:

- Delete the Optional National Service Level Agreement Plan for Qualifying Services, which expired December 31, 2014.
- Remove the Federal Telecommunications Access Service terms, rates and charges from FCC1 and FCC11, which is expired.
- Remove a grandfathered 10-year Rate Stability Plan for Advanced Video Switching from FCC1, for which there were no customers. Advanced Video Switching remains generally available to customers.
- Remove certain expired ICB cases in FCC1.
- Remove certain obsolete terms for Single Route Connect in FCC14. These terms should have been removed under Transmittal No. 392.
- Correct certain USOCs and add some USOCs.

Support material as described under Section 61.49 of the Commission's rules is not required with this filing. Associated services and revenues will be removed from Verizon's price cap indices in the next scheduled Price Cap tariff filing.

This transmittal letter and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS).
