If this commitment is not met, a credit allowance of 100% of the monthly rate for the applicable rate elements of the affected service(s) will apply. Only one such credit is allowed in a single month's billing period. Credits for 44.736 Mbps channel terminations will be based upon the rate effective and rate band applicable to the customer at the time of service failure.

- * Section 2.8.1.1(B)(7) is not available for Special Access High Capacity 1.544 and 44.736 Mbps services (DS1 and DS3 services) installed after June 1, 2006. This section contains the specific regulations governing the rates and charges that apply for Special Access Service.

7.4.1 Types of Rates and Charges

There are three types of rates and charges. These are monthly rates, daily rates and nonrecurring charges. Additionally, certain Special Access rates and charges are applied based on "Price Cap" or "Price Bands". Price Cap rates may be further differentiated by "Rate Zones".

In the states where Expanded Interconnection has become operational, Price Cap monthly rates for Standard Channel Terminations, and certain Optional Features and Functions/Basic Service Elements for 1.544 Mbps and 44.736 Mbps (electrical) Special Access High Capacity Services and certain SONET Services are arranged in pricing zones. The pricing zone for each serving wire center in the states where Expanded Interconnection has become operational is specified in the NATIONAL EXCHANGE CARRIER ASSOCIATION, INC. TARIFF F.C.C. No. 4.

Competitive Counties and Non-Competitive Counties are defined in Section 2.6 and the wire centers within such counties are listed in Section 15.4. In wire centers within a Competitive County, monthly rates and nonrecurring charges for Special Access rate elements are arranged in price bands. The price band for each serving wire center within a Competitive County is specified in Section 15.4, following.

For Interexchange Carrier Point of Presence Channel Terminations, Channel Mileage and certain Optional Features and Functions ordered for such Interexchange Carrier Point of Presence Channel Terminations, including Multiplexing, Price Band rates and charges apply regardless of whether the applicable county is Competitive or Non-Competitive. In cases where Channel Mileage crosses price bands, the charge for the higher numbered price band applies. (C)

For End User Channel Terminations and certain Optional Features and Functions ordered for such End User Channel Terminations (e.g., Bridging), the application of "Price Cap" or "Price Band" is dependent upon whether or not the serving wire center is located in a Competitive County. If the End User Channel Termination and related Optional Features and Functions are in a Competitive County, Price Band rates and charges apply. If the End User Channel Termination and related Optional Features and Functions are in a Non-Competitive County, Price Cap rates and charges apply. (C)
