- (5) For certain Special Access services, a Special Access Service Guarantee (SASG) credit allowance will apply in the event that such services experience a service interruption of four (4) or more consecutive hours except as specified in 2.7.4(B) following. The SASG credit allowance will apply to Voice Grade, monthly Program Audio and VideoConnect® TV-1 Analog, Digital Data Service (DDS), and High Capacity DS1 (excluding the portion of a DS1 service that is derived at a customer designated premises using a DS3 Premises Multiplexer) & DS3 Special Access services (collectively, Special Access Services).

The customer has the option to subscribe to National SLA Plans as set forth in Section 2.7.3 following. When a customer subscribes to a National SLA Plan, credit allowances under this Section 2.7.1.1(B)(5) do not apply to services covered by the National SLA Plan. (D)

If a Special Access Service is eligible for an SASG credit allowance, the Telephone Company shall provide the applicable credit amount as set forth in the table following. The Telephone Company shall bill customer the applicable monthly rate for the Special Access Service, and if customer is eligible to receive the SASG credit allowance, customer shall receive the SASG credit in a later invoice. Except as stated in this tariff, the SASG credit allowance is in addition to any other credit allowances available under this Section 2.7.1.1. The maximum amount of all credit allowances available under this Section 2.7.1.1 for a Special Access Service for a given billing period shall not exceed the total applicable monthly charge paid by the customer for such Special Access Service. The monthly charge will consist of all applicable rate elements charged to the circuit experiencing the service interruption. The SASG credit allowance can only be applied once per month on a per circuit basis. For multi-point circuits, the SASG credit allowance will apply to each leg of the circuit that experiences a service interruption.

All refunds under the Performance Commitment Program will be provided as a credit adjustment to the customer's bill.

(A) Performance Commitment Program - Provisioning

The Telephone Company assures that orders for interstate access will be installed and available for customer use no later than the Service Date as referenced in Section 5.1.7, Access Order Service Date Intervals. The failure of the Telephone Company to meet the service date of an order will result in the refund of all NRCs associated with that order. The Telephone Company's liability for failure to meet this commitment is limited to the refund of the NRCs for the order associated with the missed Service Date.

The customer has the option to subscribe to National SLA Plans as set forth in Section 2.7.3 following. When a customer subscribes to a National SLA Plan, credits under this Section 2.7.1.2 do not apply to services covered by the National SLA Plan. The Performance Commitment Program - Provisioning does not apply when any of the conditions set forth in Section 2.7.4(A) following exist. (D)

This section contains the specific regulations governing the rates and charges that apply for Special Access.

**7.2.1 Rate Categories**

The following rate categories apply to Special Access Service:

- Circuit Terminations
- Circuit Mileage
- Optional Features and Functions
- Non Recurring Charges
- Special Access Surcharge
- Special Access Cross Connect
- Term Payment Plan (TPP) - DS1
- Optional Payment Plan (OPP) - Fractional T1#

These rate categories are described in Sections 7.2.1. (A) through (H) following.

Additionally, certain Special Access rates and charges are applied based on "Price Cap" or "Price Bands".

Competitive Counties and Non-Competitive Counties are defined in Section 2.6 and the wire centers within such counties are listed in Section 21.3. In wire centers within a Competitive County, monthly rates and nonrecurring charges for Special Access and certain SONET service rate elements are arranged in price bands. The price band for each serving wire center within a Competitive County is specified in Section 21.3, following. For Interexchange Carrier Point of Presence Circuit Terminations, Circuit Mileage and Optional Features and Functions ordered for such Interexchange Carrier Point of Presence Circuit Terminations, including Multiplexing, (C) Price Band rates and charges apply. In cases where Circuit Mileage crosses price bands, the charge for the higher numbered Price Band applies. For End User Circuit Terminations and certain Optional Features and (C) Functions ordered for such End User Circuit Terminations (e.g., Bridging), the application of "Price Cap" or "Price Bands" is dependent upon whether or not the serving wire center is located in a Competitive County. If the End User Circuit Termination and related Optional Features and Functions are in a Competitive County, Price Band rates and charges apply. If the End User Circuit Termination and related Optional Features and Functions are in a Non-Competitive County, Price Cap rates and charges apply. (C)

Additionally, rates and charges for Integrated Optical Service Riders may also apply to Special Access connected to Integrated Optical Service Riders as set forth in Section 23.1 following.

21. Operating Territories of the Verizon Telephone Companies (Cont'd)

21.3 Competitive and Non-Competitive Counties

(A) General

Counties and county-equivalents within the Telephone Company's operating territories have been designated by the Federal Communications Commission to be either Competitive or Non-Competitive for the purposes of pricing Special Access Services.

Rates and charges are shown in Sections 5, 7, 8, and 10 preceding and Section 20 following for Special Access Services.

(1) Competitive Pricing

The rate elements associated with the transmission path are those rate elements applicable for the type of service involved. Rates and charges for competitive rate elements are shown in terms of price bands, regardless of the status of the county for a particular wire center. To determine the price band for a rate element, first locate the county and the wire center from which the service is provided in Section 21.3(C) following and find the corresponding price band. For DS3 and below Special Access Services in Non-Competitive Counties, rates and charges for End User Circuit Terminations and certain Optional Features and Functions ordered for such End User Channel Terminations (e.g., Bridging) are the Price Cap rates. Any rate element that is not labeled as either Price Band or Price Cap will apply in both Competitive and Non-Competitive Counties.
