With this filing, NBTC proposes to implement the new productivity offset (X-factor) adopted by the Commission in its Business Data Services Order FCC No. 17-43 (the “*Order*”), released April 28, 2017, and pursuant to DA 17-1009, released October 13, 2017. The *Order* established the X-factor at 2 percent for end user channel terminations and certain other non-competitive services, which will adjust price cap indexes (PCI) to account for productivity gains. One rate reduction is proposed for DS1 channel terminations for NBTC to comply with the Order.

In accordance with Section 61.14, this transmittal letter and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission’s Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS) in compliance with the electronic filing procedures.


