BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC (BellSouth) proposes to implement the new productivity offset (X-factor) adopted by the Commission in its Business Data Services Order FCC No. 17-43 (the “*Order*”), released April 28, 2017, and pursuant to DA 17-1009, released October 13, 2017. The *Order* established the X-factor at 2 percent for end user channel terminations and certain other non-competitive services, which will adjust price cap indexes (PCI) to account for productivity gains.

Based upon review and analysis of the PCI, BellSouth has determined that no rate adjustments are necessary to comply with the *Order*.

This letter and associated attachments are being filed electronically today as an **amendment** to the November 27, 2017 filing via the Federal Communications Commission’s Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS) in compliance with the electronic filing procedures.
