The Verizon Telephone Companies (Verizon) hereby apply for Special Permission for a waiver of Section 61.59 of the Commission's rules.

Under Transmittal No 1374, Verizon recently introduced unique Federal Universal Service Fund (FUSF) regulations for certain services ordered pursuant to a Federal Government contract known as Enterprise Solutions Infrastructure (EIS). As part of this filing, some existing FUSF material was also moved from one tariff page to another. Transmittal No. 1374 is scheduled to become effective June 15, 2018. Verizon's 3Q2018 FUSF compliance filing is scheduled for June 18, 2018 for effect July 3, 2018. Verizon will need to modify the EIS FUSF factor as well as rates that were in the moved material. The changes are required on material that has not yet been in effect for thirty (30) days.

Verizon therefore requests special permission to waive the requirements of Section 61.59 of the Commission's rules in order to revise material before it has been in effect for thirty days.

Illustrative tariff pages are included with this application.

This application and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS).
