

1. Introduction

Frontier Telephone Companies ("Frontier") submits herewith its Description and Justification ("D&J") in support of changes to its Access Tariffs made under Transmittal No. 89. This filing is made on behalf of the exchange carriers issuing Frontier Telephone Companies Tariffs FCC Nos. 1, 2 and 10.

2. Changes

With this filing, Frontier submits tariff pages to further modify certain tariff provisions related to Special Access Services in FCC Tariff Nos. 1, 2 and 10 in accordance with the FCC's Business Data Services Order.¹

Those changes and their justifications are:

- Increasing DS1 IC Channel Termination rates on Special Access Services to its FCC Tariff Nos. 1, 2 and 10, which was inadvertently omitted from Transmittal #88; and
- Removing the word "End User" from the "DS3 44.736 Mbps per month Competitive" rate element, which was added inadvertently with Transmittal #88 to its FCC Tariff No. 10.
