- Adds price band rates for Telecommunications Service Priority in FCC11, FCC14 and FCC16.
- Adds a CLLI to Section 14.7 of FCC1.
- Removes a regulation in FCC21 that pertained to FiberConnect.

Support material as described under Section 61.49 of the Commission's rules is not required with this filing. Any updates that are required to price cap support material will be made in the next annual filing.
