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2. General Regulations (Cont'd)2.7 Service Level Agreements2.7.1 Basic Service Level Agreements (Basic SLAs)2.7.1.1 Credit Allowance for Service Interruptions (Cont'd)(B) When A Credit Allowance Applies (Cont'd)

- (7) For certain Special Access services, a Special Access Service Guarantee (SASG) credit allowance will apply in the event that such services experience a service interruption of four (4) or more consecutive hours except as specified in Section 2.7.4(B) following. The SASG credit allowance will apply to Voice Grade, WATS, monthly Video, Digital Data (DDS), and High Capacity DS1 and DS3 Special Access services (collectively, Special Access Services). (D)

The customer has the option to subscribe to National SLA Plans as set forth in Section 2.7.3 following. When a customer subscribes to a National SLA Plan, SASG credit allowances under this Section 2.7.1.1(B)(7) do not apply to services covered by the National SLA Plan.

Additionally, the SASG credit allowance applies to IntelliMux® ports when a customer, during normal hours (see 7.2.12(D), Scheduled Maintenance), is unable to reconfigure circuits for two or more hours.

If a Special Access Service or IntelliMux® port is eligible for an SASG credit allowance, the Telephone Company shall provide the applicable credit amount as set forth in the table following. The Telephone Company shall bill customer the applicable monthly rate for the Special Access Service or IntelliMux® port, and if customer is eligible to receive the SASG credit allowance, the customer shall receive the SASG credit in a later invoice. The SASG credit allowance is in addition to any other credit allowances available under this Section 2.7.1.1. The maximum amount of all credit allowances available under this Section 2.7.1.1 for a Special Access Service or IntelliMux® port for a given billing period shall not exceed the total applicable monthly charge paid by the customer for such Special Access Service or IntelliMux® port. The monthly charge will consist of all applicable rate elements charged to the circuit experiencing the service interruption. The SASG credit allowance can only be applied once per month on a per circuit or per port basis. For multi-point circuits, the SASG credit allowance will apply to each leg of the circuit that experiences a service interruption. (T)

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5. Ordering Options for Switched and Special Access Service (Cont'd)5.2 Access Order (Cont'd)

- For Special Access Services, the customer must specify the customer premises or Hubs involved, the type of service (e.g. Video, Voice Grade, High Capacity, etc.), the channel interface, technical specification package and options desired, and the Percent Interstate Usage (PIU) as greater than or less than 10%, in accordance with Section 2.3.12, preceding. For multipoint services, the channel interface at each premises may, at the request of the customer, be different; but all such interfaces shall be compatible. For multiplexed High Capacity systems ordered to Facility Hubs except DS3 services with an optical interface, the customer must designate Hubs, specify Connecting Facility Assignment (CFA), and control channel assignment and routing of the subtending services. Voice Grade services that are ordered with compatible digital interfaces but without channel and assignment data will be provisioned, where facilities permit, on Telephone Company DS1 facilities inventory.
- For all Packet Data Services, the customer must specify the customer designated premises; when applicable, the access concentrator or packet switch location involved, and the type of service to be provided through Special Access Service (e.g., voice grade or Digital Data Service); the channel interface; technical specification package(s) and options desired; the billing options and the desired optional features.
- When establishing Special Access Service under a Shared Network Arrangement, the Host Subscriber and the Service User must coordinate with each other the design, testing and maintenance of the service; additionally, the service user must provide to the Telephone Company the Connecting Facility Assignment (CFA) and the High Capacity Billing Account Number (HBAN) of the Host Subscriber.

Upon receipt of an ASR with the required fields populated (C)
 indicating a signed letter of authorization exists for a Shared (C)
 Network Arrangement from the Host Subscriber, the Telephone
 Company will undertake to connect the Service User's circuits to
 the Host's service and to establish and maintain separate billing
 for the Service User's portion of the service. In the event that
 the Service User's is requesting a subtending circuit from a Host
 Subscriber's multiplexer which is, in term, part of a separate
 Shared Network Arrangement with a third-party Host (a cascading
 Shared Network Arrangement), the Service User must also obtain and
 provide to the Telephone Company the appropriate HBAN and CFA of
 the third-party Host, in order to identify the complete circuit
 for purposes of maintenance and testing continuity.

5.2 Access Order (Cont'd)

5.2.2 Access Order Modifications

The customer may request a modification of its Access Order prior to the service date. The Telephone Company will make every effort to accommodate a requested modification when it is able to do so with the normal work force assigned to complete such an order within normal business hours. If the modification cannot be made with the normal work force during normal business hours, the Telephone Company will notify the customer. If the customer still desires the Access Order modification, the Telephone Company will schedule a new service date. All charges for Access Order modifications will apply on a per occurrence basis.

Any increase in the number of Special Access Service channels, Switched Access Service lines, trunks, Switched Transport facilities, or out of band signaling connections will be treated as a new Access Order (for the increased amount only).

If order modifications are necessary to satisfy the transmission performance for a Special Access Service ordered by a customer, these changes will be made without order modification charges being incurred by the customer.

(A) Service Date Change Charge

- (1) For Special Access Services, Access Order service dates for the installation of new services or rearrangements of existing services may be changed, but the new service date may not exceed the original service date by more than 30 calendar days except as specified following. When, for any reason, a customer or a customer's end user indicates that service cannot be accepted for a period not to exceed 30 calendar days, and the Telephone Company accordingly delays the start of service, a Service Date Change Charge will apply. (T) (T)

If a customer or a customer's end user is unable to accept service within 30 calendar days of the original service date, the customer may elect one of the following options:

- (a) the customer may take no action, and the order will be cancelled by the Telephone Company on the 31st day with the appropriate Cancellation Charge as set forth in 5.2.3 following applied; or
- (b) the customer may choose to commence billing for the service on the 31st day.

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5. Ordering Options for Switched and Special Access Service (Cont'd)5.2 Access Order (Cont'd)5.2.2 Access Order Modifications (Cont'd)(C) Design Change Charges

The customer may request a design change to the service ordered. A design change is any change to an Access Order which requires engineering review. An engineering review is a review by the Telephone Company of the service ordered and the requested changes to determine what change in the design, if any, are necessary to meet the changes requested by the customer. Design changes include such things as the addition or deletion of optional features or functions or a change in the type of Transport Termination (Switched Access only), type of channel interface, type of Interface Group or technical specification package. Design changes do not include a change of customer premises, end user premises, end office switch, Feature Group, Lineside BSA, Trunkside BSA, or Special Access Service, or Switched Transport facilities channel type. Changes of this nature will require the issuance of a new order and the cancellation of the original order with appropriate cancellation charges applied. (C)

The Telephone Company will review the requested change to determine if it can be accommodated and if a new service date is required. The Design Change Charge will apply on a per order, per occurrence basis, for each order requiring a design change. The applicable charge is: (D)

Except as set forth in Sections 6.8.22(D), 7.4.15(A), and 7.4.16(C) following, a customer may request disconnect of an access service, in writing, at any time after the service has been established. Billing for the service involved will cease no later than 2 business days following receipt of the written notice by the Telephone Company or on the customer's requested date, whichever is later. Minimum Period Charges are applicable if the Minimum Period, as specified in 5.2.6 preceding, has not been satisfied at the time of disconnect.

5.2.8 Shared Use Facilities

Shared Use (i.e., Switched and Special Access Services provided over the same analog or digital high capacity facilities) is allowed. Shared use facilities to a Hub will be ordered and provided as Special Access Service. While shared use is allowed, individual services utilizing these facilities must be ordered either as Switched Access Service or Special Access Service. When placing the order for the individual service(s) the customer must specify a channel assignment for each service ordered.

(1) DS1 to Voice Grade

An arrangement that converts a DS1 channel to twenty-four Voice Grade channels utilizing time division multiplexing. For example, the customer has the option of ordering a DS1 to Voice Grade multiplexing for the Entrance Facility at the SWC when Voice Grade Direct-Trunked Transport is requested to an end office. A DS1 to Voice Grade multiplexing is required at the end office when the customer orders Lineside Access which is transported via a DS1 Direct-Trunked Transport facility.

(2) DS3 to DS1

An arrangement which converts a DS3 channel to twenty-eight DS1 channels utilizing time division multiplexing. The twenty-eight channels may be further multiplexed utilizing DS1 to Voice Grade multiplexers. DS3 to DS1 multiplexing is available as a chargeable optional feature for Entrance Facilities and Direct Trunked Transport facilities. DS3 to DS1 multiplexing is always required at the SWC of the customer's premises when a DS3 Entrance Facility is to connect to a lower level of capacity.

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7. Special Access Service7.1 General

Special Access Service provides a transmission path to connect customer designated premises*, either directly, or through a Telephone Company Hub where bridging, multiplexing or IntelliMux® functions are performed. In addition, Special Access provides a transmission path to connect a customer designated premises to a WATS Serving Office (WSO), to a wire center where connection to an advanced data service# occurs, or to a fiber meet location of a Verizon Dedicated SONET Ring Service as set forth in Section 23.1 following or an IntelliLight® Optical Transport Service as set forth in 7.2.14 following. Special Access Service includes all exchange access not utilizing Telephone Company end office switches, with the exception of IntelliMux® Service and WATS Access Line Service.

Special Access service may also be provided within the Corridor areas served by the Telephone Company, under the provisions of Section 2.4.7.

The connections provided by Special Access Service can be either analog or digital. Analog connections are differentiated by spectrum and bandwidth. Digital connections are differentiated by bit rate.

7.1.1 Channel Types

There are ten types of channels used to provide Special Access Services. Each type has its own characteristics. All are subdivided by one or more of the following:

- Transmission specifications,
- Bandwidth,
- Speed (i.e., bit rate),
- Spectrum

Customers can order a basic channel and select, from a list of available transmission parameters and channel interfaces, those that they desire to meet specific communications requirements.

* When Telephone Company central office switches provide local exchange service which utilize a common line which must be interconnected for interstate communications (e.g., Centrex), the Telephone Company central office, where the local exchange service ends and the access connection begins, shall be treated as a customer premises for purposes of this tariff. The physical space from which other Telephone Company services are provided, whether or not on Telephone Company property, shall be treated as a customer premises. The central office where packet data services and data base services reside shall also be included in this definition.

Advanced data services include Telephone Company provided frame relay services, switched multi-megabit services, Internet Protocol services and ATM-cell relay services. Connections to advanced data services are provided by the Telephone Company where such connections are technically and operationally feasible, as determined by the Telephone Company.

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7. Special Access Service (Cont'd)7.1 General (Cont'd)7.1.1 Channel Types (Cont'd)

Digital Data - a channel for the digital transmission of data at rates of 2.4, 4.8, 9.6, 19.2, 56 or 64 kbps.

High Capacity - a channel for the transmission of isochronous serial digital data at rates of 1.544, 3.152 or 44.736 Mbps.

High-Definition (Hi-Def) Digital Video Transport Service - a channel for one-way broadband transmission of high quality video signals in digital format, at a rate of 19.39 Mbps or 1.485 Gbps.

45 Mbps Digital Video Transport Service - a channel for one-way broadband transmission, at a rate of 45 Mbps, of high quality video signals in digital format.

Supertrunking Transport Video Service (SVS) - a channel with a bandwidth of up to either 750 MHz or 870 MHz for the transmission of multiple Amplitude Modulation (AM) standard 525 line/60 field monochrome or National Television Systems committee (NTSC) color video signals and monaural or Broadcast Television Systems Committee (BTSC) stereo audio signals over fiber optic facilities.

Detailed descriptions of each of the channel types are provided in 7.2 following:

The customer also has the option of ordering Voice Grade and analog and digital high capacity facilities (i.e., Group, Supergroup, Mastergroup, 1.544 Mbps and 44.736 Mbps) to a Telephone Company Hub for multiplexing to individual channels of a lower capacity or bandwidth. (D)

Descriptions of the types of multiplexing available at the Hubs, as well as the number of individual channels which may be derived from each type of facility are set forth in 7.2 following. Additionally, the customer may specify optional features for the individual channels derived from the facility to further tailor the channel to meet specific communications requirements. Descriptions of the optional features and functions available are also set forth in 7.2 following. (D)

For example, a customer may order a DS3/44.736 Mbps facility from a customer designated premises to a Telephone Company Hub for multiplexing to twenty-eight 1.544 Mbps channels. The 1.544 Mbps channels may be further multiplexed at the same or a different Hub to Voice Grade channels or may be extended to other customer designated premises. Optional features may be added to either the 1.544 Mbps or the Voice Grade Channels.

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7. Special Access Service (Cont'd)

7.1 General (Cont'd)

7.1.2 Rate Categories

There are five basic rate categories which apply to Special Access Service:

- Channel Terminations, including WATS Access Connections (WACs) (described in 7.1.2(A) following)
- Channel Mileage (described in 7.1.2(B) following)
- Optional Features and Functions (described in 7.1.2(C) following)
- Surcharge (described in 7.4.2 following)
- Message Station Equipment Recovery Charge (described in 7.4.3 following)

Additionally, rates and charges for Integrated Optical Service Riders may also apply to Special Access connected to Integrated Optical Service Riders as set forth in Section 24.2 following. Rates and charges for Ports also apply to a Special Access DS3 connected to a point to point SONET service as set forth in Section 24.3 following.

(A) Channel Termination

The Channel Termination rate category provides for the communications path between a customer designated premises and the serving wire center of that premises. Included as part of the Channel Termination is a standard channel interface arrangement which defines the technical characteristics associated with the type of facilities to which the access service is to be connected at the Point of Termination (POT) and the type of signaling capability, if any. The signaling capability itself is provided as an optional feature as set forth in (C) following. One Channel Termination charge applies per customer designated premises at which the channel is terminated. This charge will apply even if the customer designated premises and the serving wire center are collocated in a Telephone Company building. For WATS Access Line Service, the WATS Serving Office (WSO) is never considered a customer premises. A Channel Termination charge does not apply:

- at a DSR fiber meet location where high speed interconnection of the Company's facilities to the facilities of the customer or of a third party occurs.

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The Channel Termination rate category may also be employed to provide for connections to other service offerings.

Examples of Optional Features and Functions that are available include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Signaling Capability
- Hubbing Functions
- Conditioning
- Transfer Arrangements

A Hub is a Telephone Company designated serving wire center which may perform bridging, multiplexing, and/or IntelliMux® reconfiguration functions. The bridging functions performed are to connect three or more customer designated premises in a multipoint arrangement. The multiplexing functions are to channelize analog or digital facilities to individual services requiring a lower capacity or bandwidth. IntelliMuxsm Service allows the customer the capability to reconfigure their special access services.

7.1.3 Service Configurations

There are two types of service configurations over which Special Access Services are provided: two-point service and multi-point service.

(A) Two-Point Service

A two-point service connects two customer designated premises, either on a directly connected basis, through a Hub where multiplexing or IntelliMux® functions are performed. Two point service also connects a customer designated premises and a WATS Serving Office (WSO).

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Applicable rate elements are:

- Channel Termination(s)
- Channel Mileage (as applicable)
- Optional Features and Functions (when applicable)

In addition, a Special Access Surcharge as set forth in 7.4.2 following, a Message Station Equipment Recovery Charge as set forth in 7.4.3 following may be applicable.

DS3 Channel Mileage is provided on an individual DS3 channel basis. The DS3 to DS1 multiplexing function is available in Telephone Company Hubs as indicated in the Exchange Carrier Association Tariff F.C.C. No. 4.

(6) Shared Network Arrangement

- (a) A Shared Network Arrangement is a service offering that enables a customer (the "Service User") to connect subtending services to the multiplexed High Capacity service or IntelliMux® service of another customer (the "Host Subscriber"), with the Telephone Company maintaining separate records and billing for each. Each customer will be billed for those rate elements associated with his own portion of the service configuration. Under no circumstances will the rates or charges for individual rate elements be split. This offering is limited to service configurations where a Service User obtains either subtending Voice Grade or Digital Data Service circuits from a Host's multiplexed DS1 service, or DS1 circuits from a Host's multiplexed DS3 service. (D)
- (b) Under the Shared Network Arrangement, the Telephone Company may share with the host subscriber record information pertaining to the services of other users of the shared network. Such disclosure will be under the sole discretion of the Telephone Company as is necessary to perform billing reconciliations and/or other functions required in connection with maintaining account records.
- (c) Section 7.4.14 contains rate regulations specific to Shared Network Arrangements.

Separate nonrecurring charges apply for the installation of some of the optional features and functions available with Special Access Service. Except for SVS Video Bridging, the charge applies whether the feature or function is installed coincident with the initial installation of service or at any time subsequent to the installation of the service. The charge for SVS Video Bridging applies only when the optional feature or function is installed at any time subsequent to the installation of service.

Some optional features for which separate nonrecurring charges apply are:

- Voice Grade Data Capability
- SVS Video Bridging

(2) The Telephone Company will bill the appropriate Special Access Surcharge to the ordering customer for each interstate Special Access Service installed unless exemption certification is provided as set forth in 7.4.2 (C) preceding.

(3) If a written certification is not received at the time the Special Access Service is obtained, the Surcharge will be applied. Exempt status will become effective on the certification date indicated by the customer, subject to the regulations set forth in (4) following.

(4) Crediting the Surcharge

Payment of any Special Access Surcharge billed on WATS Access Lines, in service as of June 1, 1986, may be deferred, without penalty, for up to ninety (90) days from the date of the first bill rendered for the Special Access Surcharge.

If appropriate exemption certification is not received by the Telephone Company by the end of the ninety (90) days deferral period, the billed Special Access Surcharges will become due. These charges, if unpaid, will be subject to a late payment charge as set forth in Section 2.4.1 (B)(2) preceding.

The Telephone Company will cease billing the Special Access Surcharge when certification, as set forth in 7.4.2 (C) preceding, is received. If the status of the Special Access Service was changed prior to receipt of the exemption certification, the Telephone Company will credit the customer's account, not to exceed ninety (90) days, based on the effective date of the change as specified by the customer in the letter of certification.

7. Special Access Service (Cont'd)7.4 Rate Regulations (Cont'd)7.4.13 DS3 High Capacity Services(A) Payment Plans and Minimum Periods

Recurring charges for DS3 Services are rated and charged monthly for all commitment plans; Month-to-Month, 3 and 5-year Term Pricing Plans (TPPs). TPPs are provided with Base Rates as described in Section (B) following and as set forth in 7.5.9 following.

The minimum service period for DS3 is 12 months.

Additionally, the DS3 to DS1 Central Office Multiplexing is also available on a 3 or 5-year Term Pricing Plan. When ordered, a 3 or 5 year TPP for the multiplexing feature must have the same term period as the associated service, and it is always assigned an expiration date that is coterminous with the associated service. (D)

At the end of a term plan, the customer will not be eligible to receive discounted monthly charges unless the TPP commitment is renewed. Customers with TPPs that have expired prior to December 2, 1999, will be able to retain their service at the prevailing rates for as long as the customer retains the service.

Should a customer terminate service prior to completing the minimum period or the plan term period, termination liability may be applicable. Termination liability is assessed on channel terminations, fixed and per mile mileage, and multiplexing rate elements. Liability for terminations at a primary premises is calculated based upon the rate band determined by the last count taken. A customer who downgrades a term plan to shorter duration, changes the system configuration (i.e., Optical to Electrical) or disconnects the service will be treated as having terminated the service.

In addition to TPP, a customer may select (i) a Commitment Discount Plan (CDP), subject to the terms and conditions set forth in Section 25.1 following; or (ii) a National Discount Plan (NDP), subject to the terms and conditions set forth in Section 25.3 following.

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24. Tariffed Service Components

24.1 General

The Tariffed Service Components offered in this Section 24 are for the exclusive use of customers for connecting to the interstate services provided by the Telephone Company as described in more detail herein.

24.1.1 Shared Network Arrangement

- (A) A Shared Network Arrangement is a service offering that enables a customer (the "Service User") to connect certain Tariffed Service Components to a Telephone Company provided service of another customer (the "Host Subscriber"), with the Telephone Company maintaining separate records and billing. Each customer will be billed for those rate elements associated with his own portion of the service configuration. Under no circumstances will the rates or charges for individual rate elements be split.
- (B) Under a Shared Network Arrangement, Tariffed Service Components can connect to Telephone Company provided services as specified in the following table:

<u>Tariffed Service Component</u>	<u>Telephone Company provided service</u>
Integrated Optical Service Riders	integrated optical service
DS3 Transmux Port	point to point SONET service

- (C) When establishing a Tariffed Service Component under a Shared Network Arrangement, the Host Subscriber and the Service User must coordinate with each other the design, testing and maintenance of the service; additionally, the Service User must provide to the Telephone Company the Connecting Facility Assignment (CFA) of the Host Subscriber.

Upon receipt of an ASR with the required fields populated (C)
 indicating a signed letter of authorization exists for a Shared (C)
 Network Arrangement from the Host Subscriber, the Telephone Company will undertake to connect the Service User's Tariffed Service Components to the Host Subscriber's service and to establish and maintain separate billing for the Service User's portion of the service.

- (D) Under the Shared Network Arrangement, the Telephone Company may share with the Host Subscriber record information pertaining to the services of other users of the shared network. Such disclosure will be under the sole discretion of the Telephone Company as is necessary to perform billing reconciliations and/or other functions required in connection with maintaining account records.
- (E) Section 7.4.14 preceding contains rate regulations specific to Shared Network Arrangements.
