John Staurulakis, Inc. (“JSI”) hereby provides description and justification (“D&J”) for JSI Transmittal No. 223 on behalf of the issuing carriers for JSI Tariff F.C.C. No. 1.

INTRODUCTION

In this transmittal, JSI proposes revisions to JSI Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 for the following:

Title Pages, Table of Contents

Addition of issuing carriers effective July 2, 2019, listed at D&J Exhibit 1 (“New Issuing Carriers”), and removal of carriers exiting the JSI Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 effective July 2, 2019, shown at D&J Exhibit 2 (“Exiting Carriers”).

Section 5 Access Ordering

Ordering of Ethernet Transport Service (“ETS”) Multi-Media Virtual Circuit Channel added to orders for which the Access Order Charge does not apply, and related revisions at Section 16.4, ETS regulations.

Section 16.4 ETS Regulations

- Revisions to ETS DSL Access Service Connections, including application of the Access Order Charge referenced above.
- Updated technical reference
- Update ETS service elements subject to twelve-month minimum period to include ETS Channel Terminations
- Introduce a 500 Mbps ordering increment to the ETS Bandwidth Add-On optional feature for speeds of 1. Gbps, 2.5 Gbps and 10 Gbps. Regulations mirror the National Exchange Carrier Association, Inc. (“NECA”) regulations under which New Issuing Carriers offer service.

DESCRIPTION

The New Issuing Carriers' offerings associated with the above revisions are being filed today under the JSI Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 annual access filing, JSI Transmittal No. 224, for the fifteen (15) carriers listed at Exhibit 1:

- Twelve (12) new issuing carriers are migrating from NECA Tariff F.C.C. No. 5. As noted in Exhibit 1, two of the carriers—Clarity Telecom, LLC and Inter-Community Telephone Company, L.L.C.—are migrating from the NECA Tariff for Special Access; Switched Access services for these carriers will remain in the NECA Tariff.
- Three (3) new issuing carriers are migrating from Moss Adams Tariff F.C.C. No. 1.

A side-by-side comparison of JSI Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 regulations to NECA Tariff F.C.C. No. 5 regulations is attached hereto as D&J Exhibit 3. Moss Adams Tariff F.C.C. No. 5 mirrors those of JSI Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 in all material respects.

No introduction of new rates for issuing carriers are proposed in this filing.

These revisions are necessary to allow seamless transition for New Issuing Carriers concurrent with cancellation as issuing carriers for NECA Tariff F.C.C. No. 5 and Moss Adams Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 effective July 2, 2019, as well as for the Exiting Carriers.

This transmittal is a companion filing to JSI Transmittal No. 224, the required 2019 annual access filing.

CONCLUSION

This transmittal provides for the addition of New Issuing Carriers to JSI Tariff F.C.C. No. 1. Allowing the revisions proposed in JSI Transmittal No. 223 to become effective will facilitate the seamless migration of New Issuing Carriers' services and rates from NECA Tariff F.C.C. No. 5 and Moss Adams Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 to JSI Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 effective July 2, 2019.
