In conjunction with the FCC's Second Report and Order in WC Docket No. 17-84 (FCC 18-74) released June 8, 2018 (Zero Demand Forbearance), with this filing NBTC will add language that provides that it is no longer required to offer certain services in geographic areas where there are no customers subscribing to those services and it has received no reasonable requests within the prior 30 days. No existing customers are affected by this filing, nor are any areas affected in which NBTC is already providing services to existing customers. The only change occasioned by this tariff filing is that, in the event a potential customer requests one of the affected services in an area where NBTC is not already providing the service and has no existing customers, NBTC may decline the request for service.

In accordance with Section 61.14, this transmittal letter and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS) in compliance with the electronic filing procedures.
