

DESCRIPTION AND JUSTIFICATION

1.0 Introduction and Description of Filing

In this tariff filing, scheduled to become effective December 4, 2019, Somos, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as “Company”) proposes changes to Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, 800 Service Management System (SMS/800) Functions (SMS/800 Tariff) including: notice regarding the decommissioning of the MGI and WBA access methods in April 2021; a change of Somos corporate address; and, incorporation of the requirement for Resp Orgs to provide contact information for parties to post-auction secondary market transactions. The proposed modifications are detailed below.

1.1 Modify Regulations and Service Offerings

- All pages, changed the corporate address.
- On pages 10 and 11, add notice regarding the planned April 30, 2021 decommissioning of the MGI and WBA access methods. TFN Registry users have been notified of this upcoming change to access methods.
- Section 2.1.8, add ability of Company to suspend Resp Orgs that do not comply with the requirement to provide contact information of parties to secondary transactions of post-auction toll-free numbers. This suspension does not require thirty (30) day notice, and Resp Org service will be restored after the required information is provided.
- Section 2.3.7(D), added a new section outlining the requirement for Resp Orgs to provide contact information of parties to secondary market transactions. The Resp Org providing service to the subscriber is responsible for providing the names, addresses, emails and phone numbers of the parties, and it has sixty (60) days from the time it has actual knowledge of the transaction to deliver the information to Company.
- Section 3.3.3, note that MGI and WBA access will be decommissioned on April 30, 2021.
- Section 3.5, note that MGI and WBA access will be decommissioned on April 30, 2021.
