With this filing, Verizon submits tariff pages to detariff certain Special Access services from its tariffs, as required by the Commission in FCC Order No. 17-43, released April 28, 2017 and Report and Order on Remand, FCC 19-66 (released July 12, 2019), as detailed in the following:

- The following competitive services are being detariffed from FCC1: Serial Component Video Service; High Definition Digital Video Transport Service; IntelliLight® Shared Single Path (Special); Advanced Video Switching; IntelliMux Service; all other price band terms, rates and charges including Special Access Ordering Charges, Voice Grade Service, WATS Access Line Service, Digital Data Service, High Capacity Service, Basic Video Service, Federal Government Special Access Services, Special Access Additional Engineering Charges, Special Access Additional Labor Charges, and Special Access Testing Services.

- The following competitive services are being detariffed from FCC11: Serial Component Video Service; High Definition Digital Video Transport Service; IntelliLight® Dedicated SONET Ring, IntelliLight® Shared Single Path (Special); Advanced Video Switching; NYNEX Enterprise Services; NYNEX Enterprise Network Reconfiguration Service; all other price band terms, rates and charges including Special Access Ordering Charges, Voice Grade Service, WATS Access Line Service, Digital Data Service, DIGIPATH digital service II, High Capacity Service, Broadcast Video Service, Federal Government Special Access Services; Special Access Additional Engineering Charges, Special Access Additional Labor Charges, Special Access Maintenance of Service Charges, and Special Access Testing Services.
- The following competitive services are being detariffed from FCC14: MetroLAN Special Transport and all other price band terms, rates and charges including Special Access Ordering Charges, Voiceband Service, Digital Data Service, High Capacity Service, Federal Government Special Access Services; Special Access Additional Labor Charges, Special Access Maintenance of Service Charges, Special Access Testing Services, and Telecommunications Service Priority.
- The following competitive services are being detariffed from FCC16: MetroLAN Special Transport, and all other price band terms, rates and charges including Special Access Ordering Charges, Voice Grade Service, Digital Data Service, High Capacity Service, Federal Government Special Access Services; Special Access Additional Engineering Charges, Special Access Additional Labor Charges, Special Access Maintenance of Service Charges, Special Access Testing Services, and Telecommunications Service Priority.
- The following services are being detariffed because the demand for these services exists only in Competitive Counties: All state specific rates and charges for the states of Connecticut, Delaware, New York, North Carolina, Rhode Island and the District of Columbia (all of which are 100% Competitive Counties), Basic and Multichannel Video Services in FCC1; 45 Mbps Digital Video Transport Service in FCC1 and FCC11; Supertrunking Transport Video Service in FCC1 and FCC11; Fiber Based Multichannel Video Service in FCC11; IntelliLight Shared Dual Path (Special) in FCC1; Advanced Uncompressed Digital Video Service in FCC11; Broadcast and Advanced Broadcast Video Service in FCC11; and Enhanced Access Diversity optional feature in FCC11.
- The following services are being withdrawn due to zero demand: IntelliLight® Shared Assurance Network (both Switched and Special) in FCC1; IntelliLight® Shared Single Path (Switched) in FCC1 and FCC11; and Controller Arrangement in FCC1 and FCC16. Regulations are also being deleted for InfoPath Packet Switching Service in FCC11, which was withdrawn due to zero demand under Transmittal No. 1385.

- References to SONET and Ethernet services that are already offered on a detariffed basis are being deleted when they appear on any pages included under this filing.
- Verizon is also grandfathering a term under discount/commitment plans that allows a customer to discontinue the plan without termination liability in the case of a rate increase. Customers in existing discount/commitment plans are not impacted by these changes.

Support material as described under Section 61.49 of the Commission's rules is not required for this filing.

This transmittal letter and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS).
