With this filing, NBTC is proposing to cease offering an optional feature of its Intercept Referral Service. Intercept Referral Service is provided when a customer's telephone number is temporarily or permanently disconnected or changed. Calls to the intercepted telephone number are provided a recorded message, indicating that the number has been changed, and, if available and/or the customer elects, information such as the new telephone number is provided.

Effective on or after December 31, 2019, NBTC will no longer offer the ability for customers to customize their recording, such as providing their new telephone number, by removing the word "operator" from the rate category description. However, NBTC will continue to provide Intercept via an End Office Announcement recording, which will inform the caller that the number being dialed has been disconnected.

In accordance with Section 61.14, this transmittal letter and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariffing System (ETFS) in compliance with the electronic filing procedures.


