John Staurulakis, Inc. (“JSI”) hereby provides description and justification (“D&J”) for JSI Transmittal No. 231 on behalf of the issuing carriers for JSI Tariff F.C.C. No. 1.

INTRODUCTION

In this transmittal, JSI proposes revisions to JSI Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 for the following:

Title Pages, Table of Contents

Addition of issuing carriers effective July 1, 2020, listed at D&J Exhibit 1 (“New Issuing Carriers”)

Maintenance revision to add Section 16.10 Optical Network Transport Service to the Table of Contents.

Removal of 17.4.8 Public Packet Data Network from Table of Contents for Moundridge Telephone Company, Smithville Telephone Company and Twin Valley Telephone, Inc. Rates and Charges. The foregoing carriers are existing 61.50 carriers and will detariff Public Packet Data Network rates and charges effective July 1, 2020 under JSI’s annual access filing Transmittal No. 232.

Section 6 Switched Access Ordering

Maintenance revision at 1st Revised Page 6-100.1 to correct references from Section 6.10.3 to 6.9.3.

Section 7 Special Access Service

Maintenance revision at 1st Revised Page 7-14.3.

Section 16.4 ETS Regulations

Revisions to remove the restriction that an ETS Port cannot be added to or replaced in an existing ETS Term Discount Plan during the last year of the commitment period. These revisions are proposed to mirror the National Exchange Carrier Association, Inc. (“NECA”) regulations under which New Issuing Carriers offer service.

DESCRIPTION

The New Issuing Carriers' offerings associated with the above revisions are being filed today under the JSI Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 2020 annual access filing, JSI Transmittal No. 232, for the fourteen (14) carriers listed at Exhibit 1. All New Issuing Carriers are migrating from NECA Tariff F.C.C. No. 5.

A side-by-side comparison of JSI Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 regulations to NECA Tariff F.C.C. No. 5 regulations is attached hereto as D&J Exhibit 2.

No introduction of new rates for issuing carriers are proposed in this filing.

These revisions are necessary to allow seamless transition for New Issuing Carriers concurrent with cancellation as issuing carriers for NECA Tariff F.C.C. No. 5 effective July 1, 2020.

This transmittal is a companion filing to JSI Transmittal No. 232, the required 2020 annual access filing.

CONCLUSION

This transmittal provides for the addition of New Issuing Carriers to JSI Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, as well as the maintenance revisions described above. Allowing the revisions proposed in JSI Transmittal No. 231 to become effective will facilitate the seamless migration of New Issuing Carriers' services and rates from NECA Tariff F.C.C. No. 5 to JSI Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 effective July 1, 2020.
